### Diarrhoea & Vomiting

Home Farm adheres to the Public Health England guidelines, which state that the exclusion period is until the infected person has been free of symptoms for 48 hours.

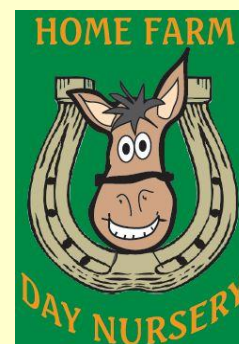

Get your children excited in the great outdoors. Please take a leaflet from the parent board which details ideas for activities you can enjoy outside.



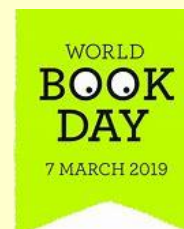
