Please remember that we require a full change of clothes to be provided daily.

#### Antibiotics

Please note that children are excluded from nursery for 24 hours from first administration of prescribed antibiotics (in case of adverse reaction).

#### Diarrhoea & Vomiting

Home Farm adheres to the Public Health England guidelines, which state that the exclusion period is until the infected person has been free of symptoms for 48 hours.

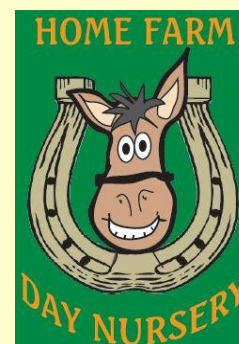


### Animal man
