Antibiotics

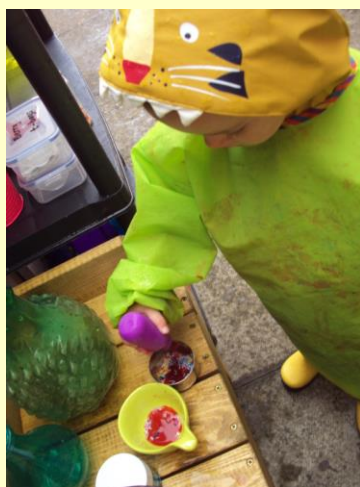
Please note that children are excluded from nursery for 24 hours from first administration of prescribed antibiotics (in case of adverse reaction).

Potion station gallery

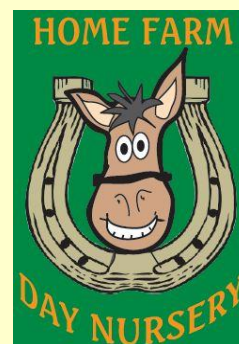
Squirrels having fun concocting weird and wonderful potions using our new 'potion station'.



Halloween week



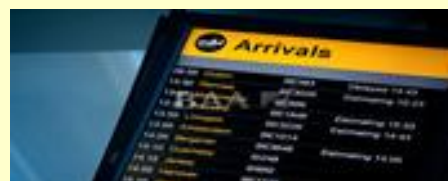
Throughout the week of 26th October children are invited to wear spooky fancy dress as the nursery builds up to Halloween. Themed craft activities are planned for the whole week.
