### Diarrhoea & Vomiting

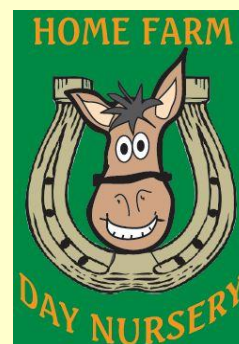
Home Farm adheres to the Public Health England guidelines, which state that the exclusion period is until the infected person has been free of symptoms for 48
